- Farmer's Markets - Shalom has been approached as site for Farmer's Market on Saturdays selling produce grown by stall holders. Around 50 stalls with approx \$6 each to Shalom. Some issues with committing school grounds on weekends possibly limiting school activities. Will discuss further.
