- Master planning is ongoing and meetings underway with Council relating to development requirements.

Agenda Items:

Driver Safety Programme – feedback received was positive and will look at possible dates again for this year and a venue closer to Bundaberg if available.

Car Draw Sub-committee Report– Toni Sergiacomi and Traci Thornton have agreed to manage the organisation of the Car Draw this year with a good number of interested parents joining committee.

Markets Sub-committee - Takings have been down considerably due to bad weather. Canteen needs to remain open while there are still people at the markets even when numbers are low. Number of families volunteering this year has dropped and was noted that the number of times volunteers would be called on would reduce considerably if more families volunteered. Need to look at encouraging more volunteers as this is the major source of funds for the P&F and this money flows directly into resources for the school.

Rowing Report - pontoons are back and training has started with a good number of coaches and approx 90 students signed up. Maintenance period has been successful with boats now in Shalom colours.
